- Professional & positive attitude to being a role model as a coach

# **DESIRABLE EXPERIENCE & SKILLS:**

- Experience of coaching at competitive level
- Openness and enthusiasm for learning & developing yourself further
- Relevant judging qualification, or a desire to gain this as part of your CPD

# **ROLE PURPOSE:**

- To provide safe, positive & developmental coaching to all club members
- To support colleagues and work as a team to deliver the club's timetable
- To represent the club and its members at appropriate venues and events

# **MAIN TASKS:**

- Prepare & deliver suitable content for classes/gymnasts you are assigned, including adequately
  preparing any competitive gymnasts for events they will participate in.
- Arrive a minimum of 10 minutes prior to the start time of your sessions in order to prepare the training area, liaise with other coaches regarding the use of space & equipment, and welcome your gymnasts in to prepare for their session.
- Ensure that all club policies are followed during your sessions and that any accidents, injuries or similar incidents are recorded & reported to the Director of Coaching.
- Provide adequate advance notice to the Director of Coaching, whenever possible, of any sickness absences or periods of absence that would affect your ability to work your agreed hours.
- When cover is required, arrange a substitute as directed in the Staff Handbook / your contract.
- Support the growth & development of the club's staff and volunteers through mentoring, training & opportunities to gain experience, where appropriate.
- Act in a responsible & appropriate manner at all times in accordance with the club's Codes of Conduct, Safeguarding Policy (and related policies) and best ethics & practice.
- Maintain & update your required qualifications in line with Scottish & British Gymnastics policy.
